### The Order of the Mass

- quick review of last week: the development of the Liturgical calendar  
Daily Prayer (The Liturgy of the Hours), Breaking of the Bread (Sunday Mass) always a celebration of Easter, honoring the Saints, developing use of color, establishment of Church "Seasons"

- Ordinary Time = Green, Advent = Violet, Christmas = White, Lent = Purple, Easter = White, Martyrs (and the Holy Spirit) = Red

- Ritual/Rite: a ceremony with standard words and gestures

- Vatican Council II affirmed that the "Mass is the summit of Catholic worship."  
(Christ - Christ - Christ - Christ)

- The Order of the Mass: I) Liturgy of the Word II) Liturgy of the Eucharist

Mass = to be sent Liturgy = the work of the people Eucharist = Thanksgiving

- Vocabulary: alb stole chasuble chalice paten tabernacle  
sanctuary lamp altar stone corporal purificator  
presider/presidential chair (Cathedral)

Roman Missal Lectionary (Year I/Year II; A, B, C) Book of the Gospels

- Liturgy of the Word:

Greeting, Penitential Rite ("Lord Have Mercy"), (Gloria), Collect (Opening Prayer), First Reading, Responsorial Psalm, Second Reading, Verse Before the Gospel ("Alleluia"), Gospel, Homily, Creed, Universal Prayer (Prayer of the Faithful/General Intercessions)

- Liturgy of the Eucharist:

Preparation of the Altar and Gifts ("Offertory"), Offertory Prayer, Eucharistic Prayer, Lord's Prayer (Our Father), Sign of Peace, Breaking of the Bread/Communion Rite, Prayer After Communion, Blessing, Dismissal
